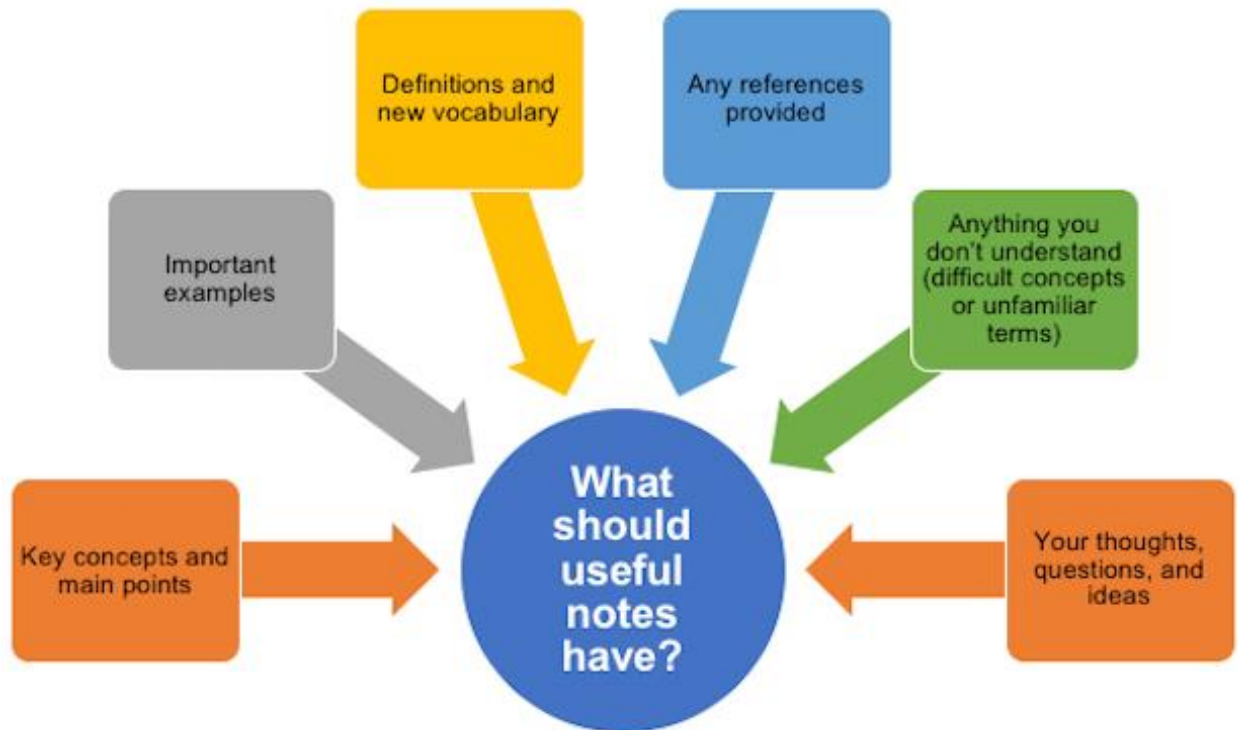


Note Taking Guide



Some additional ideas for good note taking...

- Sometimes, half the battle is knowing the teacher's style...is s/he a stickler for detail? Concerned about the "why"? Big picture type of person? So you ask your teachers questions!
- Source & date your notes/readings.
- Take notes in the margins of readings or take notes on paper as you read. Mark the page numbers/source of the reading that your notes go with.
- Highlighting...small amounts of important info.
- Bracket & annotate...larger chunks of important info.
- Color code...with various pens/highlighters.
- *Google* words you don't know...and make sure you are getting the definition in the proper context.
- Look for CAUSE & EFFECT (before & after).
- Who, what, when, where, why, how, wow!
